

BASIC NEEDS

Pray that basic needs would be provided. Water, food and shelter.

And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:13

Pray that those who can provide will do so.

John the Baptist gives these instructions: And the crowds were questioning him, saying, "Then what shall we do?" And he would answer and say to them, "The man who has two tunics is to share with him who has none; and he who has food is to do likewise. Luke 3: 10-11

Pray that channels will be open to get supplies to needed areas. (not left in ports to ruin, given only if there is a bribe or confiscated by enemies.)

"Teacher, what shall we do?" And he said to them, "Collect no more than what you have been ordered to." Some soldiers were questioning him, saying, "And what about us, what shall we do?" And he said to them, "Do not take money from anyone by force, or accuse anyone falsely, and be content with your wages." Luke 3:12-14

Pray for wisdom for those distributing the goods..for physical and emotional strength, honesty and fairness.

He has told you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you But to do justice, to love kindness, And to walk humbly with your God? Micah 6:8

The Lord will give strength to His people; The Lord will bless His people with peace. Psalm 29:11

Pray that the supplies will give nourishment and strength and will not run out.

Indeed, forty years You provided for them in the wilderness and they were not in want; Their clothes did not wear out, nor did their feet swell. Nehemiah 9:21

I Kings 17..story of Elijah and the Zarephath widow. Verse 16 The bowl of flour was not exhausted nor did the jar of oil become empty, according to the word of the Lord which He spoke through Elijah.

Pray for sufficient shelter for the displaced. Many are homeless especially orphans who live on the streets.

I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. John 14:18

Pure and undefiled religion in the sight of our God and Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their distress. James 1:27

Pray for prisoners to be given these basic needs.

Remember the prisoners, as though in prison with them, and those who are ill-treated, since you yourselves also are in the body. Hebrews 13:3

Pray for sleep and rest. The IDP camps are congested and noisy without adequate sleeping arrangements. Prison conditions are deplorable and not conducive to sleep.

In peace I will both lie down and sleep, For You alone, O Lord, make me to dwell in safety. Psalm 4:8
